Some medical conditions present increased risk. Below are some examples of conditions that would likely result in a TriTerm Medical plan application being declined.

Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS)  
or Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)

Alzheimer's

Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)

Autism

Bipolar disorder

Cancer

Cerebral palsy

Chronic liver disease, including Cirrhosis, Hepatitis B, or Hepatitis C

Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) or emphysema

Crohn's or ulcerative colitis

Currently pregnant or adopting

Cystic or pulmonary fibrosis

Diabetes (except gestational)

Down's syndrome

Facility confinement (within the past 12 months, excluding pregnancy)

Heart or circulatory system disease or disorder

Multiple Sclerosis (MS)

Muscular Dystrophy (MD)

Organ transplant recipient

Paralysis

Parkinson's disease

Rheumatoid or psoriatic arthritis

Schizophrenia

Stroke or thrombosis

Substance abuse or addiction

Unexplained weight loss in the last 12 months
